Job Description

Your responsibilities will include (but are not limited to) the following:

- Ensure the physical and emotional wellbeing of children in your care.
- Collect prescription and over the counter medicine provided by guardians.
- Distribute medicine per detailed instructions from guardians.
- Secure and monitor all camper and staff medications in the medic cabin.
- Prepare and supply emergency first-aid med packs for out-trips.
- Keep the medic cabin clean, sanitized, and tidy in a productive manner.
- Maintain a high level of energy and enthusiasm regardless of the weather / situation.
- Monitor inventory and replenish required medic supplies with approval.
- Triage sick / injured campers, provide appropriate care, or seek emergency services.
- Record all visitors to the medic and treatment provided.
- Model acceptable behaviour through a professional demeanour.

- Criminal Reference Check (Vulnerable Sector Search) & Child Intervention Check
- EMT, Paramedic, Registered Nurse, Medical Doctor or 80 Hour First Aid
