



Camp Details

We are very excited to have you join us at camp. This is our home and a place of sanctuary. It is only rented to one group at a time to ensure the privacy and safety of our guests. We ask that you treat us, our property, and the surrounding area with respect.

Linens & Toiletries

- Bring your own linens such as bedding for a twin mattress, sleeping bags, and towels.
- Hand soap, toilet paper, and paper towel are supplied and included.
- We do not provide personal toiletries like shampoo and body wash.
- Feminine hygiene products and paper towels cannot be flushed down the toilet.

Cleaning

- The camp should be left in the same condition it was when you arrived.
- Items in cabins, mess hall and kitchen must not be removed or used for other purposes.
- Groups will be charged for stolen items and to repair any damages incurred.
- We sanitize all surfaces, empty garbage cans, stock supplies, and mop floors.
- Additional cleaning above and beyond this will be charged at \$25 / hour.

Facility Details

- Close all doors behind you. Every door must remain tightly closed at all time.
- No candles and smoke machines (or similar devices) are allowed in any of our buildings.
- Do not leave any litter, garbage bags, or food outdoors (especially overnight).
- Our fire suppression system is very sensitive. Do not touch any of the overhead pipes.
- Refrain from ringing the bell without permission from a Cadicasu staff member.

Kitchen & Catering

- If you are renting the kitchen, all people cooking must attend a detailed orientation.
- There is a maximum of 5 people allowed in the kitchen at all times.
- Anyone under the age of 16 years old is not allowed to operate any kitchen equipment.
- Items in the kitchen must stay there and only be used for food (not for painting or crafts).
- If we are providing the catering, nobody will have access to the kitchen.
- Food is served buffet-style during caterings. Be conscious of portion control.

Communication

There is WIFI available, but limited cell phone reception. A landline is available for emergency use (403) 851-8124.



Weather Conditions & Terrain

Camp Cadicasu is located within Kananaskis Provincial Park. This means that we are in a forest with wildlife and uneven / unmanicured terrain on and around our property. We will shovel and salt stairwells and entrances to buildings in anticipation of your arrival. However, it is your responsibility to dress appropriately for unexpected weather and terrain. Please pay extra attention to your surroundings for anything unpredictable.
